## **Our Program**

Pitch In is dedicated to ensuring that students from Chicago's Englewood, Humboldt Park, and North Lawndale neighborhoods transition from middle to high school with the skills, mindsets, and agency to succeed. Pitch In partners with Chicago Public Schools (CPS) elementary schools to boost student outcomes in 4th-8th grade, and we are committed to improving the culture and support systems surrounding the middle school space district-wide, including:

- Working closely with school partners to provide a tailored in-school and after school socialemotional relationship-based program model that also engages families.
- Supporting 4th grade students weekly in cohorts to engage in our social-emotional learning curriculum and enrichment opportunities, all supported by consistent adult mentors, full-time staff, and peers.
- Grouping students with our Middle School Champions who are a diverse group of caring adults from all walks of life; college students, business professionals, stay at home parents, artists, etc., caring adults that serve as consistent Champions for our students.
- Building trust, providing resources, and more experiences for growth, fun, and self-care with our students and their families growing the program for our 5th-8th grade cohorts.

Ultimately, Pitch In helps students develop the skills and mindsets necessary to succeed in high school and far beyond.

- Preparing materials for the in-school and after school program, tracking and analyzing data, event planning for school events and student excursions leading to seamless communication around all aspects of student support, and any tasks deemed by Pitch In staff.
- Engaging with and contributing to the Pitch In staff and working collaboratively on initiatives aligned with mission, goals, growth projections, and stakeholder events.
